


FORMULATION OF AMCOW WATER QUALITY PROGRAM

BACKGROUND



The African Ministers' Council on Water (AMCOW) is mandated to advance the development of water and sanitation sector in Africa



Ensuring water security is a significant part of this mandate, and AMCOW considers water security to entail both quality and quantity, which is why AMCOW Secretariat committed in its 2020-2014 Strategic Operations Plan to design and roll out a pan-African program on Water Quality.



AMCOW wishes that the design of the new program builds on the rich experiences and lessons from past and ongoing water quality initiatives across Africa by different players, including African Union institutions, and the wider members of the World Water Quality Alliance (WWQA), for which AMCOW sits on the Strategic Advisory Committee. AMCOW is therefore developing a program - the AMCOW Pan-African Water Quality Program (PAWaQ).

GOAL

The ultimate goal of AMCOW is the creation of a strong, self-driven water quality program and movement in Africa through PAWaQ to promote collective action, and to ensure protection of water quality as a critical element in enhancing water security in Africa.

PHASE 1

Assessment on WQ monitoring initiatives and capacities in Africa



Assessment of initiatives and capacities on pollution control and impact mitigation



PHASE 3

Assessment of possible innovations to African water pollution and mitigate risks quality monitoring to incorporate into Phase 1



PHASE 4

Assessment of possible innovations to prevent through circular economy and incorporate into Phase 2



PHASE 5

Consultation and validation of Phase 4; and Formulation of an operational AMCOW **WQ** program for Africa
