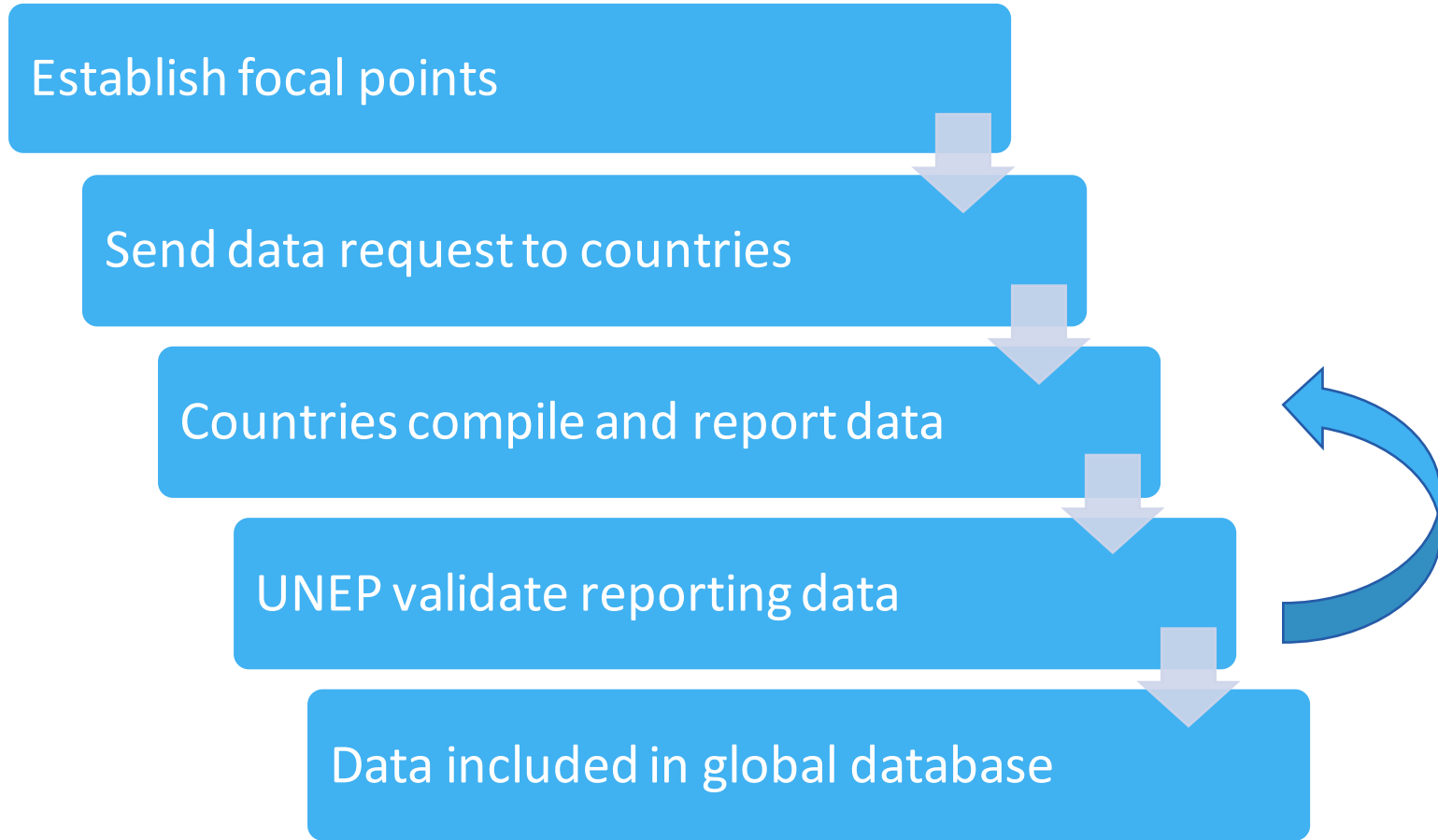

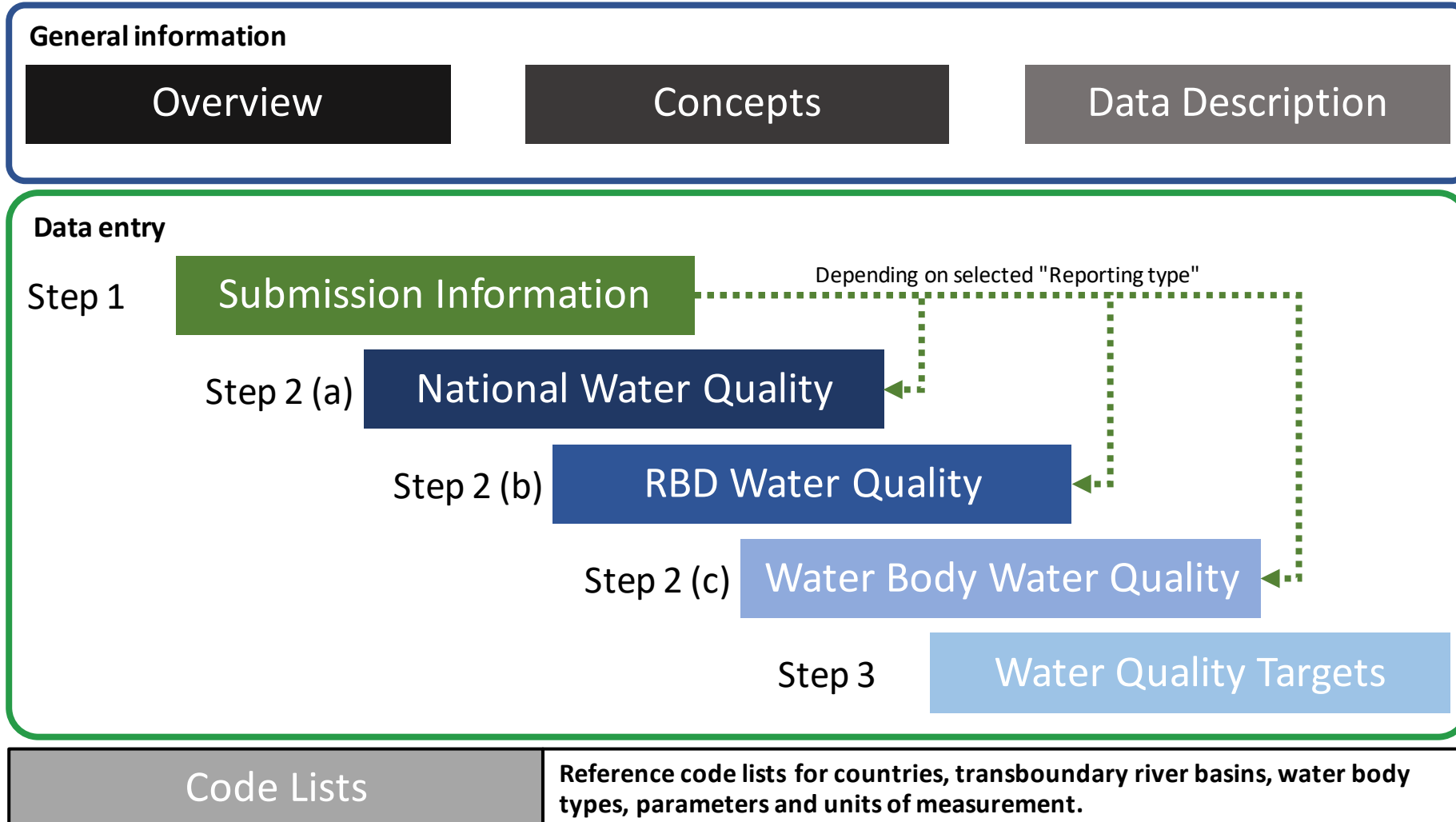

- Starting next April 2023!






